CONDITIONS OF HIRE

- 1. The keys may be collected from, and must be returned to, the Bookings Secretary, Honor Vane
- 2. The hire charge will commence when the keys are collected and will end when the keys are returned.
- 3. The full hire charge must be paid to the Bookings Secretary when the keys are collected, together with a deposit of £300. The deposit will be refunded, subject to the hall being left in a satisfactory condition see conditions 5 and 6 below.

Please note that, where heating is required, there will be an additional charge per hour.

- 4. In the event of the hire period exceeding that paid for (i.e. if the keys are not returned by the specified time), the additional hire charge will be deducted from the deposit.
- 5. In the event of any loss or damage being caused to the hall or its contents during the period of hire, the cost of repair or replacement will be charged to the hirer.
- 6. The hirer will be responsible for ensuring that the premises are left in a clean and tidy condition and **all rubbish removed from the premises and taken away**. Should additional cleaning be necessary as a result of the hiring, the cost of this will be charged to the hirer.
- 7. The hirer will be responsible for ensuring that the conditions of the music and dancing licences are strictly observed. A copy of these is displayed in the hall. Attention is drawn particularly to the hours when music and dancing is permitted between 7.0 p.m. and midnight on Monday to Friday and between 3.0 p.m. and midnight on Saturday.
- 8. The hirer will be responsible for ensuring that noise is kept to a reasonable level so as not to cause a nuisance to nearby residents.
- 9. The hirer will be responsible for ensuring that adequate parental supervision is provided throughout any event involving young persons.
