### CHESTNUT AVENUE DIAMOND JUBILEE PROJECT

In celebration of the Queen's Diamond Jubilee, everyone is being encouraged to plant a tree. This autumn, Dinton with Ford and Upton Parish Council will be filling in several gaps in Chestnut Avenue, Dinton, with 30 new trees.

The current chestnut trees are unfortunately suffering from two different diseases; the plan is to leave them in situ and to plant small leaf lime trees, *tilia cordata* in between them in the areas cleared with the help of Bucks County Council. so when they die, or become unsafe, they will be replaced by the new trees.

We have already received a number of pledges to buy a reasonably mature lime tree at a cost of £50.00.
